SUGGESTED CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST

Everything that is brought to camp should have your child's name clearly marked on it. Camp cannot be responsible for lost items, so please do not send anything of true value!

It is not necessary to buy new clothes or equipment! The list below is only a suggested one. Please feel free to modify this list to best meet your daughter's needs.

Laundry is sent out twice. Be sure to send enough clothes to span a two to three day "in-the-laundry" lag.

Please tape or paste an accurate list (such as the one below) of your daughter's belongings in the top inside cover of her trunk. This helps the packing procedure on the last day of camp.

- 6 pairs of shorts
 - 3 pairs of jeans or long pants
 - (for riding or hiking)
 - 10 T-shirts/play shirts
 - 3 long sleeve shirts
 - 2-3 appropriate outfits (for church, trips, etc.)
 - 10 pairs of socks (some tall for hiking)
 - 4 pairs shoes
 - One must be tennis shoes
 - One old pair for "creek walks"
 - One for church, trips, etc.
 - Wet weather shoes
 - Optional :hiking boots
 - 1 raincoat or poncho
 - 1 hat (sun protection while active)
 - 2 warm sweaters or sweatshirts, jackets, etc.
 - 2 bathing suits
 - 10 pairs underwear
 - 2-3 pajamas
 - 2 warm blankets
(the nights can get quite cool)
 - A "Crazy Creek" or equivalent chair is an optional but fun chair for camp gathering
- 4 single flat sheets
 - 2 pillow cases
 - 1-2 pillow
 - 4-8 towels, wash cloths
 - 2 laundry bags
 - flashlight with extra batteries
 - canteen
 - tennis racquet
 - 2 cans of tennis balls
 - sleeping bag for overnights
 - stationery WITH STAMPS
(letter writing twice in a week required)

Optional Sports Equipment might include: sleeping bag for overnights; riding hardhat and boots; lacrosse stick; hockey stick; etc.

Books, games, batteries, musical instruments; costumes; etc.

Campers may want to bring an inexpensive treat for "Peanut Pal" Day. This is a day that campers have a secret pal for whom they do "random acts of kindness" all day and reveal themselves at the camp gathering at the end of the day. The operative word is "inexpensive", \$15 dollars MAX!!

Personal Hygiene: shower caddy to keep things organized, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, soap dish, comb, sunscreen, **bugspray WITH DEET**, etc. **Please bring lice repellent shampoo and conditioner, "Babo Botanicals" is an excellent option.**

ANY MEDICATIONS are kept with the Directors.

One Camp Lachlan shirt is given to each camper. (Others may be purchased on the final day of Camp if desired.)
